Fantasy Players Auditions

Monday Night, August 16 at 6:30 p.m. at the Fantasy Arts Center
For Junior High and Senior High School Students

Fantasy Players is an auditioned group of students who serve as an ambassador-touring group for Fantasy Playhouse Productions. They perform short skits and plays for schools, nursing homes, Early Works, Panoply, and more. Fantasy Players rehearse on Monday nights 6:30 – 8:30 p.m. Rehearsals and performance dates run from September to the first week of June.

This is a large commitment!!!

Class Descriptions

The Acting Bug

Students will learn the fundamentals of acting, stage directions, notations, and terminology. Through participation in scene work, students will learn what a script is and how to use it. Basic work in characterization will also be covered in this weekly 1-hour class. Once you have taken this course, you will definitely have caught “*the acting bug!*”

Audition101

This class is designed for the novice performer wishing to audition for community theater drama productions or just to learn what an audition is all about. The class will learn what is expected at an audition, how to pick out audition material, and how to perform said material successfully. This class meets once a week for 1 hour.

Break-a-Leg Drama

This class will use modern and not-so-modern stories to encourage and enhance beginning acting skills with complimentary games and improvisation. Try your luck at this “Break A Leg” drama class. This was the most requested class last year. This class meets once a week for 1 hour.

Dance Classes: Those Happy Feet. Gotta Dance , & So You Wanna Dance?

Put on your jazz shoes or tennis shoes; get on floor and DANCE! These classes are designed to give the actor some experience in choreographed movement for the stage. *Those Happy Feet and Gotta Dance* will have beginners concentrating on dance basics in jazz, hip hop and musical theater. The intermediate class, *So You Wanna Dance*, requires some dance training and will continue the study of jazz, hip hop, musical theater, and contemporary. *Those Happy Feet* meets once a week for 45 minutes while all other dance classes meet once a week for 1 hour.

Fractured Fairy Tale Drama (New)

What would happen if the three bears were cowboys -- or if Cinderella met the three little pigs? In this class, it's up to the students! Students will use their imaginations to create new stories using some familiar fairy tale characters. Then they will use their voices and bodies, along with a few costumes and props, to bring these fractured stories to life. This class meets once a week for 45 minutes for 5-6 years and 1 hour for 7-8 years.

Improve with Improv

This fast paced hilarious class offers older students the chance to challenge their creativity and their quick thinking skills with a variety of theatrical games that help create “on-the-spot” characters and situations each week in this hour class.

Jelly Bean Society

The Jelly Bean Society is popular with the beginning elementary age drama student who likes to “dress up” and act. The students will turn international fairy tales into unique theater works while learning to develop characters through their body and voice. This class meets once a week for 45 minutes.

Kindermusik: ABC Music & Me™

ABC Music & Me™ created by Kindermusik supports the early childhood standards and requirements for “high quality programs” as defined by the National Institute for Early Education. In this class for ages 2-3 years, the child will experience the following: songs and rhymes to develop phonetic awareness and early reading skills; tapping, clacking, and ringing rhythm instruments in time with music to improve hand-eye coordination; focused listening with music to improve skills in following directions; instrument play to strengthen fine motor skills; developmentally-appropriate songs to develop vocal chords and expressive speech; and learning that emphasizes storytelling, imaginative play, and taking turns. You will receive (3) home material sets which portray a different theme every 4 weeks. These sets all together are valued at \$57. This class meets once a week for 45 minutes for 12 weeks. ***This class is for a student with a parent or caregiver. Due to limited space, other siblings may not attend the class. Kindermusik® Imagine That!

Kindermusik Imagine That! is a curriculum specifically for 3-and 4-year olds and is designed to enhance the development of the “total child” through integrated learning that includes music, movement, pretend play, and literature. In *Hello Weather, Let's Play Together!*, the child will explore sunshine, rain, snow, thunderstorms, and more in this imaginative and delightful weather-related musical adventure. The parent/caregiver joins the class for the last 10-15 minutes. ***Other siblings may attend the last 10-15 minutes with the parent as long as they do not disrupt the class program and there is space.*** Tuition for **new Imagine That** students is \$162 (includes home materials and a backpack valued at \$64). Tuition for **continuing Imagine That** students is \$156 (includes home materials and no backpack valued at \$58). The class meets once a week for 45 minutes for 12 weeks. ***All students must be potty trained and must be able to participate in the class without mom's presence for at least 30 minutes.** For more information about Kindermusik, go to www.kindermusik.com

Kindermusik® Our Time

Kindermusik Our Time is a music and movement program for children ages 1 ½ - 3 years with a parent or caregiver. Our Time focuses on your child's emotional development as his/her confidence, curiosity, self-control, and communication begin to take shape. The cost of the class includes the *Milk & Cookies* home materials valued at approximately \$54. *Milk & Cookies* empowers Parent and Child to explore familiar, everyday home activities such as cooking, dusting, and washing clothes through musical activities and creative play. This class meets once a week for 45 minutes for 12 weeks. ***This class is for a student with a parent or caregiver. Due to limited space, other siblings may not attend the class. For more information about Kindermusik, go to www.kindermusik.com***

Kindermusik® Village

Kindermusik Village is designed for baby 3 ½ -18 months and his/her primary caregiver. Village combines music, movement, and touch to stimulate your baby's neural pathways, affecting motor coordination and cognitive, social and emotional development. A very special bonding experience and an education for adults in the foundations of learning are the rewards of this class for parents. Village meets once a week for 45 minutes. **Session A** meets for 6 weeks (August 23– October 11). **Session B** meets for 6 weeks (October 25 – November 29). You may elect to take only Session A or only Session B individually or you may sign up for both sessions A & B which are offered at a discount rate. **Session A** is a 6- week class called *Zoom Buggy* exploring the many ways Baby and Parent can Zoom! Experience the *vroom* of a rocket ship and the *swoosh* of the canoe oars—all through a variety of instruments. The tuition of \$98 includes home materials valued at approximately \$39. **Session B** is a 6-week class called *Dream Pillow*. This class invites parents to sing to baby in their own style. Songs and activities are designed to help Baby and Parent incorporate music into many of their routines at home. The tuition of \$98 includes home materials valued at approximately \$39. ****You do not have to have taken Session A to take Session B.*** If you sign up for both Sessions together you will get the discount rate of \$176. ***This class is for a student with a parent or caregiver. Due to limited space, other siblings may not attend the class. For more information about Kindermusik, go to www.kindermusik.com***

Kindermusik® Young Child 1 and Young Child III

Kindermusik for the Young Child is a two-year, sequential program ensuring that a child receives a complete musical experience. Students ages 5-7 will sing folk songs, learn to play simple instruments such as the glockenspiel, dulcimer, and recorder as well as learn to read and write elementary musical notation. Caregivers join in for the last 10 minutes of class. The cost of Semester 1 class is \$174. Tuition includes home materials with glockenspiel and carry bag valued at approximately \$77. Semester 3 is \$174. Tuition includes home materials with dulcimer and carry bag valued at approximately \$77. You must have had Semester 2 to take Semester 3. These classes meet once a week for 1 hour in 12-week sessions. ***Other siblings may attend the last 10-15 minutes with the parent as long as they do not disrupt the class program and there is space. Visit www.kindermusik.com***

Star Struck Drama

This course introduces the more advanced beginner to all the basic theater terminology and acting methods. Acting students will explore and develop appropriate characters from plays and perform convincing monologues from said plays as well as learn to work with others in an ensemble situation. Students who have taken *The Acting Bug** class or students who have had some acting experience will fine-tune their acting skills in this more advanced one-hour drama class. ****The Acting Bug class is not necessarily a prerequisite but recommended.***

Spotlight Drama

Develop your acting skills as we spotlight a variety of basics such as pantomime, improvisations, voice control, monologues, and sketches. This class strengthens your confidence and sharpens your acting skills so that you can have fun in the "spotlight!" Class meets once a week for 1 hour.

Story Drama I

Story Drama I uses an eclectic collection of costumes, props, and crafts (who knows what) to create stories, skits, and fun improvisations. Well known fairy tales, and some not so well known tales, will be used to unleash the creative imagination of your child. This class is perfect for introducing the young child to the world of dramatic arts. This class meets once a week for 45 minutes.

Tiny Tunes

This high energy beginning musical theater class will have your kids singing like pros! Students will learn how to present a song for musical auditions. This is one of our most popular classes for the young singer. This class meets once a week for 1 hour.

Registration and Cancellation Policies

Class Reservation, Deadline Dates, & Tuition Payments

To reserve a space in a class, a minimum of ½ the tuition for each class must be paid by check, cash, or money order, payable in advance to Fantasy Playhouse. Any remaining balance is due the first day of class.

The reservation deadline for Academy Classes is August 12, 2010. Kindermusik participants must reserve a space in class by August 2, 2010 or incur a \$13 late fee after that date. (Late fees only apply to Kindermusik classes). **It is suggested that you register as early as possible as our classes tend to fill up quickly.*

Cancellations

A minimum of 5 students is required for any Fantasy class to make. Fantasy Playhouse reserves the right to cancel a course due to insufficient enrollment. In the event of course cancellation, the student will receive a full refund. **Participant cancellations made more than 2 weeks prior to the start of class will receive a full refund minus a \$20 non-refundable processing fee. No refunds will be given for participant cancellations made less than two weeks prior to the start of class.** However, a credit in that amount (minus a \$20 non-refundable processing fee) may be taken for future classes. **No refunds or credits are given for withdrawals after classes begin.** Acknowledgement that you have read and understand these policies **is required** on the registration form. **Also read Academy Staff.*

Schedules and Weather

We observe the same holiday schedule as the Huntsville City Schools. If Huntsville City Schools are closed due to inclement weather, Fantasy Playhouse Academy of Theatre will also be closed. The instructor will schedule make-up classes as needed.
