Acting for American Girls

Based on the popular historical dolls and books, this class will explore some of the *American Girl*® stories and give students a chance to perform selected scenes

CSI: Fantasy Kid Detectives' Drama Camp (New)

A CSI Fantasy Kid Detective will learn about fingerprinting, code breaking, handwriting and ink experiments taken from the crime scene. This is your chance to learn how to solve mysteries and become a Junior Crime Scene Investigator. Bring a hat from home to learn about disguises and participate in other crime scene activities to solve mysteries in class. You will listen to stories and learn about other super sleuths. If that is not enough to get students excited, campers will also audition for parts, rehearse, learn dialogue; and gather props and costume pieces-- all in preparation for the camp's production of *CSI: Mother Goose Land*. Must be at every class. The tuition includes all class materials. Limited enrollment!

Dive Into Drama

Get your feet "wet" with this beginning acting course, pantomime, characterization, and improvisation will be explored, as well as basic theater terminology. Students get an introduction to the world of theater and this class is a good course to prepare the student for the more expanded beginning class *The Acting Bug* offered in the fall and winter sessions.

Drama Audition

If You Give a Class a Stage

Students will use their voices and bodies to act out the funny scenarios depicted in the well-known *If You Give a...* series of children's books. They will also work together to create and perform an original "If You Give a..." story.

Joy of Sewing

Learn to sew with Fantasy costume seamstresses Pam Anders & Marie Sexton. The two and one half-hour class meets each day for one week in the costume room of Fantasy. In BEGINNING SEWING, you will learn basic sewing skills by constructing a pillowcase, a simple tote bag and a pair of sleep pants. In INTERMEDIATE SEWING, good knowledge of basic sewing or a previous sewing class is required. You will be making a pillowcase with contrasting band, a lined tote bag and pajama pants. In ADULT BEGINNING/INTERMEDIATE SEWING, a good knowledge of basic sewing or a previous sewing class is required. You will be making a fun tote bag and a pair of scrub style pajamas. Learn to make your sewing projects on our sewing machines or bring your own machine (with instruction manual if possible). The tuition does not include pattern, thread, or fabric. *Upon signing up you will be mailed information on the pattern and fabric requirements.* A small sewing accessories kit is included in the tuition. Class size is limited so register early!

Kindermusik Adventures® Zoo Train or Creatures in the Ocean or Creatures in My Backyard

Registration and Cancellation Policies

Class Reservation, Tuition Payments and Deadline Dates

To reserve a space in a class, tuition must be paid in full for each Academy class and at least ½ the tuition must be paid for any Workshop, Kindermusik® Class, all Camps or Sewing Class. Any remaining balance is due the first day of class. All full tuition payments and/or balances are to be paid by check, cash, or money order, payable to Fantasy Playhouse. Cancellations
